History of the Scholarship

In July 1995, the Maine Dental Association received a sum of money from the estate of MDA Past President Alva S. Appleby, "in trust...for the purpose of establishing a scholarship or scholarships for students from the State of Maine to attend dental school." Since 1995, MDA members have made additional voluntary contributions to the fund. The MDA awarded the first annual scholarship(s) during the 1997-98 academic years. Since only the interest will be used to provide the scholarships, the amount of the awards may vary, but will be at least \$2,500.00.

Criteria for Applications

The Maine Dental Association Charitable Foundation will review the applications and choose the scholarship recipient(s) based upon the following criteria:

- Be from the State of Maine
- Be enrolled in a dental school accredited by the American Dental Association and having completed the first year.

Procedure for Application

Interested parties can apply online at www.medental.org or request a paper copy by contacting the office (see contact below). The application should be completed and returned by Friday, November 22, 2024. In addition to the completed application form, please include the following in order to be considered:

- One personal reference
- Two dental school instructor references
- A current dental school transcript
- A personal statement explaining your choice of dentistry as a career and your future goals, stated in your own words and without the use of artificial intelligence (AI) or any other type of powered writing assistants.

Criteria for Selection

The Maine Dental Association's Foundation Board of Trustees will review the applications and choose the scholarship recipient(s) based upon:

- Academic performance
- Essay/personal statement

The recipient(s) will be notified by the Maine Dental Association when the grants have been awarded.
